In the late 1980s, the academic bodies of the University of Milan set out a programme designed to aimed at obtaining new locations for innovative research activities in strategic sectors and extend teaching offerings to disciplinary areas absent at that time in the local public institution. In September 1993, the Milan City Council determined that the Bicocca area would be the site of Milan's new university hub. On June 10, 1998, the second University of Milan was established by Ministerial Decree. The Bicocca campus is located in the Milan neighborhood of the same name, once home to large industrial companies such as Pirelli and Breda. The new university became part of a large-scale redevelopment project launched around 1986 and coordinated by the architect Vittorio Gregotti.



Also known as 'La Statale', the University of Milan is a relatively young university on the national scene. It was founded in 1924 thanks to the tenacious efforts of Luigi Mangiagalli, a physician and gynecologist, who thus realized his longnurtured dream of an athenaeum for the Lombard capital. Always characterized by a multidisciplinary and innovative educational proposal with an eye toward the new professionalism required by a rapidly changing world of work, the University has also strengthened over time its efforts on the front of technology transfer and application development of the results of scientific research in the economic-productive context.
